

Текст аудиозаписи для заданий 1–5

Сейчас Вы будете выполнять задания по аудированию. Текст прозвучит два раза. После первого и второго прослушивания у Вас будет время для выполнения и проверки заданий. Bessie: Hi, John! Yes, I am!

There's no one to tell you to do your homework. And when your paper is due, you suddenly realize that all the time you'd spent at parties you should have spent studying. Are you looking forward to living on your own?

Bessie: Honestly? I am. I wouldn't want to go to college too far away from home, though, I would want to visit my parents on the weekends. But I still want to feel independent.

John: Do you already know what you would like to major in?

Bessie: Not really. I realize I need to choose something practical. But I cannot think of anything that I really like. What I'm really interested in is ancient history and archeology. But how practical can that be?

John: Well, you never know. You could be a university professor with that major. But you still have time to think about it.

Bessie: What are you majoring in?

John: Game design.

Bessie: Game design? You mean videogames? Seriously?

John: Yes! Isn't that cool? I really like to play computer games, so I thought designing them would be both practical and fun for me.

Bessie: Wow! That's smart. I love videogames! Listen, I need to go, I've got so much homework to do. But it was really nice talking to you.

John: Same here! Say hello to your brother! And tell him I'm back. We should do something together.

Bessie: Sure! He'll give you a call. Bye!

John: Bye!
